We look forward to even better results next season.

Our Region Championships again provided wonderful bowls, and all events were closely contested. Thank you to Graham Down for again doing the draws, Barry Ferguson for arranging the venues and Mike Limosani and Elaine Owens for presenting the medals at the end of each event. We had winners from nine of our Clubs.

State Champions Week was held at Bendigo, and our Region winners performed very creditably. A Marchioli and N Murray won the Men's Pairs, N Murray was runner-up in the Men's Singles. M Gibson and J Neville were runners-up in the Ladies' Pairs, and T Doolan runner-up in the Ladies Champion of Champions. Overall, Yarra finished second in the competition which was a very good effort. Congratulations to all those Region players who helped us reach this placing.

Our State representatives were Tris Doolan, Makayla Gibson and Josh Corless. (State sides)Brad Gibson and Dean O'Neill in Under 25s, and Mario Cipolla and Ray Jansen in the Over 60s. Congratulations to all these players.

I would like to thank all the members of the Board who have again been outstanding in their work over the past 12 months. Our Secretary Peter Russell has done a wonderful job communicating with the Clubs, keeping us informed of any changes that come from Bowls Victoria and himself being involved in many activities within the Region. Our Treasurer Elaine Owens, continues to control our finances with care, and also was involved in presenting Championship medals and Super Veterans badges. Graham Howard has been in charge of the Greens Committee and also kept the Board informed with his knowledge of Bowls Victoria operations. Mike Limosani has been an energetic member, helping with the Men's Region Side, being on the Greens Committee, and presenting Region Championship Medals. Ros Camera joined the Board and has been a good contributor throughout the season. Louise Mejean filled a casual vacancy on the Board during this season and I am sure will make a valuable contribution to us in the future.

At the last Annual General Meeting we farewelled Lorraine Burton who has been on the Board since its inception, and who held various positions on the Board, including two years as President. She has been a wonderful contributor to the Region.

# Treasurer's report

It is my pleasure to once again present this report to the members of the Yarra Bowls Region.

Through careful planning we have maintained the finances to be in a sound financial position after seven years of trading without having to increase the levy to the clubs.

Unfortunately some of the expenses that are showing in this report occurred in the 2016-2017 financial year. We did not receive the website account till this financial year hence a double up of payment showing. The ambulance bill received by one of the players who represented the region at the Regional championships last year was submitted to us in this financial year together with an account for accommodation at Bendigo last year.

It has been a policy of this region to subsidise our players who represent the Region at State and National level. We had a triples team representing Victoria at Merimbula this year and we had players who qualified for finals on day two of their respective events where prize money won was less than reasonable expenses incurred for accommodation, petrol etc. at the Bendigo State Championships.

Bowls Victoria contribute to each region with a subsidy for the teams attending the Regional State Sides Championships at Swan Hill and this year at Traralgon for the men but accommodation costs etc. rise every year and the region must cover all expenses

It was decided by your Executive that we would present to the winners and runners-up of our region events medallions as a memento of their achievements. This was well received by the successful players.

This year it was necessary to purchase a supply of hats as part of our uniform. We now have sufficient to cover the next couple of years.

Honorariums were paid to the Greens Committee and to the Umpires Panel. We thank the recipients for all their time and efforts in undertaking their tasks.

Once again I thank our member clubs for adapting to the electronic transferring of funds to the region. This is a very safe and secure method of paying accounts.

In closing I would like to sincerely thank my co board members for their assistance and wish the incoming committee every success for the coming season

#### Match committee

Once Bowls Victoria issue their calendar of events we sit down and integrate our events into the schedule and avoid clashes wherever possible. We then establish closing dates for all our events, and update entry form templates and publish them. Then there's the recording of entries, issuing of draws, arranging greens and liaising with various event managers.

We continued running our singles events in a three person sectional format which has proved ideal for relieving the pressure on clubs to provide markers for the early rounds of the event. This season we continued running our triples and fours as twilight events which proved popular.

Fortunately we had an increase in participation overall which enabled to cover the shortfall in these events. A minimum of 20 teams in each event is needed to cover costs.
