- b) Minutes of all meetings posted to our website after approval at subsequent director's meetings


6) Presentation

- a) Elaine Owens then spoke about the efforts of Lorraine Burton, including her service as Secretary at Hurstbridge, President and Secretary of VLBA Group 14, steering committee member with the formation of the Yarra Bowls Region, and then service as President and Vice President of the Yarra Bowls Region
- b) Beth Chittenden then presented Lorraine with a certificate of appreciation for her efforts.

- d) This season the executive decided to purchase medallions for the winners / runners up in region events
- e) Our State Triples Champions (S Feguson (Donvale) T Doolan (MCC) and M Gibson (Bundoora RSL) will contest the Australian Championships in the ladies triples competition played in late November at Merimbula. The region has provided some financial assistance for each of the players. This assistance occurs where players are required represent our region in country / interstate locations over multiple days
